- 2. The Highlanders Museum will hold an 'open sale' of Regimental Property on **Tuesday** 10th April 2012 between 10.30 and 16.00 hrs
- 3. Interested parties may Bid for Item(s) as follows;
 - a. By **phone** (week days) to **01463 224380** from receipt of this document to Thursday 5^{th} April 2012. (The Home HQ has no ansaphone so do not call before 8am or after 5pm on weekdays or at weekends. (Remember Easter $6^{th} 9^{th}$ April)
 - b. By **e-mail** anytime to; ITC-MA@mod.uk (Maurice Gibson) or appeal@thehighlandersmuseum.com (Kirstin Mackay). E-mail bids to be in by NLT 09.00 hrs on Tuesday **10th April** 2012.
 - c. By **post** to; Maurice Gibson Museum Property, Home HQ, The Highlanders, Cameron Bks, Inverness, IV2 3XE. Postal bids to be with Home HQ by NLT Thursday **5**th **April** 2012. (Remember Easter 6th 9th April).
- 4. Interested parties (placing a Bid) must provide their Full Name, Address and Contact Telephone Number. (See Bid Proforma attached). Successful bidders who cannot be present on 10th April, to pay for and collect their Item(s) will be contacted by phone.
