DAY 01

GLASGOW/LONDON HEATHROW TO SINGAPORE

Fly from Glasgow to London Heathrow by British Airways/British Midlands
Overnight stay at airport hotel London Heathrow

DAY 02

LONDON HEATHROW/BRUNEI via SINGAPORE

Depart from London Heathrow for Brunei via Singapore.

DAY 03

SINGAPORE/BRUNEI

Arrive Singapore and connect flight to Brunei.

Arrive Brunei, meeting, assistance on arrival and transferred to your hotel.
Overnight stay at **Hotel Centre Point or similar for 3 nights (4 Star)**

DAY 04

BRUNEI

Meals Included-Breakfast-Lunch

Morning proceed for full day sightseeing tour of the city. This tour will give you a detailed outlook of Bandar sri Begwan the capital city of Brunei. The tour will begin with pick up from your hotel. You will visit Morning Market, Brunei Museum, Sultan Omar Ali Saifuddien Mosque, Hassaniil Bolkian Mosque and photo stop at the entrance of the biggest residential palace in the World Istana Nurul Iman which is the official residence of His Majesty the Sultan of Negara Brunei Darussalam. Lunch at a local restaurant is also included.

After lunch, continue with visit to the Royal Regalia Museum which was built in 1992 to commemorate the Silver Jubilee of His Majesty's The Sultan of Brunei accession to the throne in 1967. The museum houses a collection of royal paraphernalia and also an exhibition on the Constitution of the nation. After that, proceed on a local boat for a cruise around the water village, and into the mangrove to search for the proboscis monkey, view the Royal Palace from the boat thereafter disembark from the boat and return to hotel.

Free at leisure. Overnight stay in **Brunei**

DAY 06

BRUNEI-TUTONG-SERIA-MIRI

Meals Included-Breakfast-Lunch

Morning after breakfast, depart from Brunei, overland to Miri by coach. Enroute visit Lutong and Seria Anduki Airfield (**visit subject to approval**). Stop for

lunch at a local restaurant in Kuala Belait. After crossing the immigration drive to Miri, on arrival check into hotel and free at leisure

Overnight stay at ***Mega Hotel or similar for 1 night (3-4 Star)***

DAY 07

MIRI-KOTA KINABALU-SANDAKAN

Meals Included- Breakfast

Morning visit Lutong town followed by a short city tour with a visit to Malaysia 1st Oil Well or the Grand Old Lady located at Canada Hill, the largest Taoist Temple in South East Asia - San Chi Tien and Miri City Fan.

After tour, transfer to the airport for your flight to Sandakan via Kota Kinabalu.

Meet on arrival at Sandakan airport and transfer to hotel for check-in at Hotel Sandakan.

Overnight stay at ***Hotel Sabah or similar for 2 nights (4 Star)***

DAY 08

MIRI-KOTA KINABALU-SANDAKAN

Meals Included-Breakfast –Dinner

Morning visit the Sepilok Orang Utan Rehabilitation Centre in Sepilok which is located about 25 kilometers west of Sandakan. The centre was opened in 1964 as the first official orangutan rehabilitation project for rescued orphaned baby orangutans from logging sites, plantations, illegal hunting or kept as pets. The orphaned orangutans are trained to survive again in the wild and are released as soon as they are ready. The sanctuary is located within the Kabili-Sepilok Forest Reserve which covers an area of 5529 ha, much of which is virgin rainforest. Today around 60 to 80 orangutans are living free in the reserve. It has become one of Sabah's top tourist attractions

Continue tour with visit the War Memorial and followed by a short city tour before returning to the hotel. Evening transfer to Ocean King Restaurant for dinner.

Overnight stay in ***Sandakan***

DAY 09

SANDAKAN-RANAU-KUNDASANG

Meals Included: Breakfast-Lunch-Dinner

Depart Sandakan in the morning for Ranau on the way crossing parts of the infamous "Sandakan - Ranau Death March" route. Enroute brief stop at Muanad (further inland, where one of the first POWS escaped from the Death March. Next stop will be past the little township of Telupid for lunch. After lunch, leave for the Sabah Tea Plantation for in insight of the Sabah Tea Garden and a short tour of the Tea Factory. Continue our journey to the Ranau Memorial (also known as Cleary Memorial) and the last Camp. Then on to Kundasang arriving in the late afternoon and check into Mt Kinabalu Heritage Resort & Spa for the night.

Overnight stay at ***Heritage Mt. Kinabalu Resort & Spa or similar (3-4 Star)***

Day 10

KUNDASANG-KOTA KINABALU

Meals Included: Breakfast/Dinner

Morning check-out and proceed to the beautifully kept Kundasang War Memorial and Gardens. Depart for Kinabalu National Park, the first Heritage site in Sabah. Visit the Exhibition Hall or take a walk at the Mountain Garden. Continue journey to Kota Kinabalu and on the way stop at Nabal Market for local handicraft or other souvenirs

Arrive Kota Kinabalu and check into **Hyatt Regency Hotel**. Evening transfer to Kg. Nelayan Restaurant for Dinner & Cultural Dance.

Overnight stay at ***Hyatt Regency Hotel or similar for 1 night (4 Star)***

DAY 11

KOTA KINABALU-SINGAPORE

Meals Included: Breakfast

Free till time to transfer to airport for flight to Singapore. Arrive Singapore, meet and transfer to hotel. Free at leisure.

Overnight stay at ***Swiss Hotel or similar for 4 nights (4 Star)***

DAY 12

SINGAPORE

Meal Includes: Breakfast/Lunch

Morning proceed for city tour of Singapore with a drive around the Civic District past the Padang, Cricket Club, Parliament House, Supreme Court and City Hall. You'll have great views of Marina Bay when you stop for photos at Merlion Park and the Merlion itself, Singapore's mythological creature that is part lion, part fish. Later enjoy a 30 minutes boat ride along the Singapore River.

Then, continue your journey northwards to the Kranji War Memorial. Unveiled in 1957, the memorial commemorates over 20,000 men and women who gave their lives for freedom in World War II. Lunch at a local restaurant and then continue visit Changi Chapel & Museum. The museum focuses on the memories and lives of both POWs and civilian internees who survived the Japanese Occupation while the Changi Chapel is a replica of the original chapel found in the Changi Prison. Visit to Selerang Garrison (**visit subject to approval**) before returning to hotel and free at leisure. Overnight stay ***Singapore.***

Day 13

SINGAPORE/JOHOR BAHRU

Meal Includes: Breakfast

Morning after breakfast cross over by coach to Johor Bharu via 2nd link – the causeway linking Singapore and Malaysia. After crossing the causeway we arrive in Johor Bharu and drive to Kota Tinggi for a visit to Pulada the Jungle Training School (**visit subject to approval**). After visit return to Singapore and free at leisure.
