

## South Atlantic Medal 1982 (Without rosette)

Recently a Government ordered review recommended that the qualifying date for the "Falklands Medal" be extended to allow for the fact that many personnel were still operating in hazardous conditions, subject to potential attacks by the Argentinians and in very real danger until the completion of the new airfield in October 1982. This recommendation has been accepted by HM Government and personnel who were with 1 QO HLDRS and attached personnel (A Coy 1 QLR/137 (Java Bty RA and others) in the Falklands until 21 October 1982 now qualify for the medal without the rosette.

Form to be completed in BLOCK CAPITALS. Entries for regiment **SCOTS DIV (QO HLDRS)** and dates are shown below. If you were Advance Party then the date changes to 1 July 1982. Don't worry if you arrived later or left early due to posting/courses etc (Some people left early to do the SAA Instr course at Glencorse for example). So long as you did **30 days on Ascension Island, on board the Norland/ a trooping aircraft or in the Falklands by 21 October 1982** then you qualify. The medal office will sort dates if you are not sure. The dates shown are for Main Body. The dates are also in your Red Book.

Forms should arrive at the Medal Office from the 1st of October 2014.
