

The Queens Own Highlanders' Trustees met today in Cameron Barracks (on a poignant anniversary for the regiment) for their twice yearly meeting to discuss matters relating to the regimental finances, the maintenance of the Queens Own Highlanders Collection held at Fort George, and the workings of the Museum Board in its first year of operation since the Highlanders Museum refurbishment.

On the financial issues (but not the Association Funds) the trustees were briefed on the investment performance by Neil McKerrow, the Chair of the Investment Committee and on the Museum finances by John Bailey, the Company Secretary of the Highlanders Museum Ltd. The trustees also received the Museum Director's Annual Report which included updates on the Collection.

The trustees also noted that members of the Museum Board and the Trustees (Councillor Alex Graham (the Provost of Inverness), Douglas Young and Peter Grant Peterkin) had agreed to meet privately with three petitioners in Inverness on 12 March. Kelvin Hunter has been asked to provide a suggested agenda prior to the meeting. The outcome of this meeting will be posted on the Association website.
