
SCOTTISH NATIONAL VE DAY 75TH COMMEMORATION EDINBURGH 8TH MAY 2020

Please now find below the outline of timings for Friday 8th May 2020. Timings may be subject to change nearer the time. If they do change drastically I will update everyone closer to the time.

OUTLINE TIMINGS 8TH MAY 2020

- 08.00 Final set up of Ross Band Stand
- 08.00 Sound check and rehearsals for performers and orchestra
- 09.00 Rehearsal for RBLS Riders Branch
- 09.20 Rehearsal for youth groups flag bearers at Ross Bandstand
- 09.30 Horse boxes move to holding area
- 09.30 Veterans Breakfast Club Meeting at The Royal Scots Club, Abercromby Place
- 09.45 Riders Branch and SMVG move from King Stable Road to the Parade Assembly area At Eastern side of George Street on the South carriageway at St Andrew Square
- 10.00 Road closures come into effect on George Street
- 10.15 VIP arrival at Assembly Rooms
- 10.30 WW2 Veterans arrive at Assembly Rooms
- 10.45 Parade personnel arrive in assembly area at East side of George Street at St Andrew Square
- 11.15 Horses move from holding area along the North Carriageway of George Street
- 11.25 VIP and WW2 Veterans take position on saluting dias outside Assembly Rooms
- 11.30 Parade steps off following route George Street to Castle Street.
 - Horses will move back to Charlotte Square once they have passed the saluting dias
 - SMVG will proceed directly to Red Blaise in Princes Street Gardens
 - RBLS Riders Branch will enter through St Cuthbert's and take up position between
 The Ross Fountain and Ross Band Stand to line the route
 - Once dismissed in Castle Street all parade members will move across Princes Street
 And into Princes Street Gardens to the Ross Band Stand
 - Youth Groups will position National Flags to surround the Ross Band Stand
 - The RAF Pipes and Drums will move to the Western Side of Princes Street Gardens
 To lead WW2 Veterans to the Ross Band Stand
 - All VIP vehicles will pick up VIPs once the parade has passed and will proceed to the rear of the Ross Band Stand
 - All Fares for Free vehicles will pick up WW2 Veterans and take them to Princes
 Street Gardens
 - The senior person attending will be invited to welcome all WW2 Veterans and those attending
- 12.30 Concert begins
- 13.30 Interval until 14.00
- 13.45 Flypast 2 x Typhoons
- 14.55 The National Toast
- 15.00 Single round fired from time gun at Edinburgh Castle
- 15.00 VE 75 Pipe Tune played from Edinburgh Castle by solo Piper
- 15.10 Finale (RAF Pipes and Drums)
- 15.15 Dispersal and clear up
