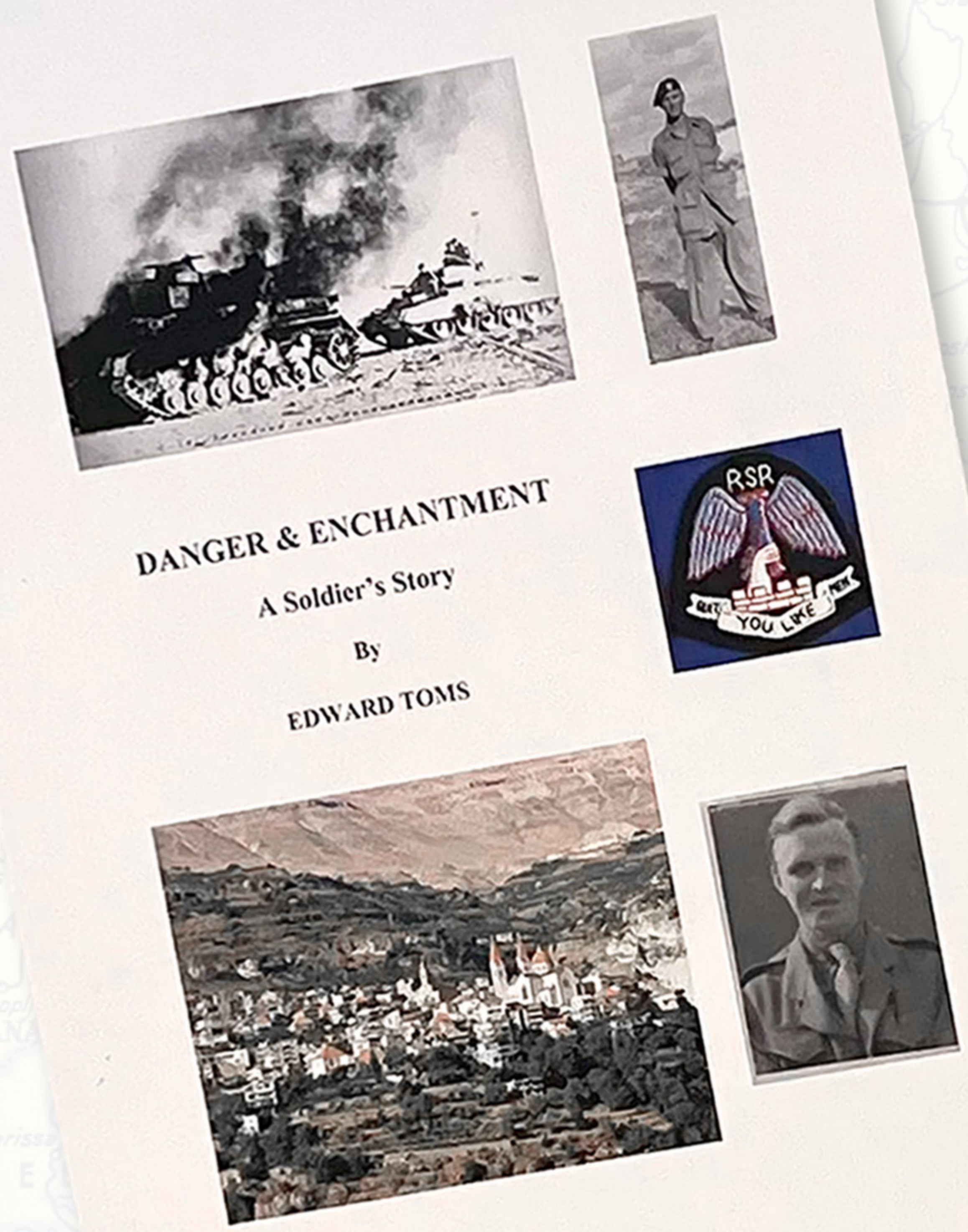
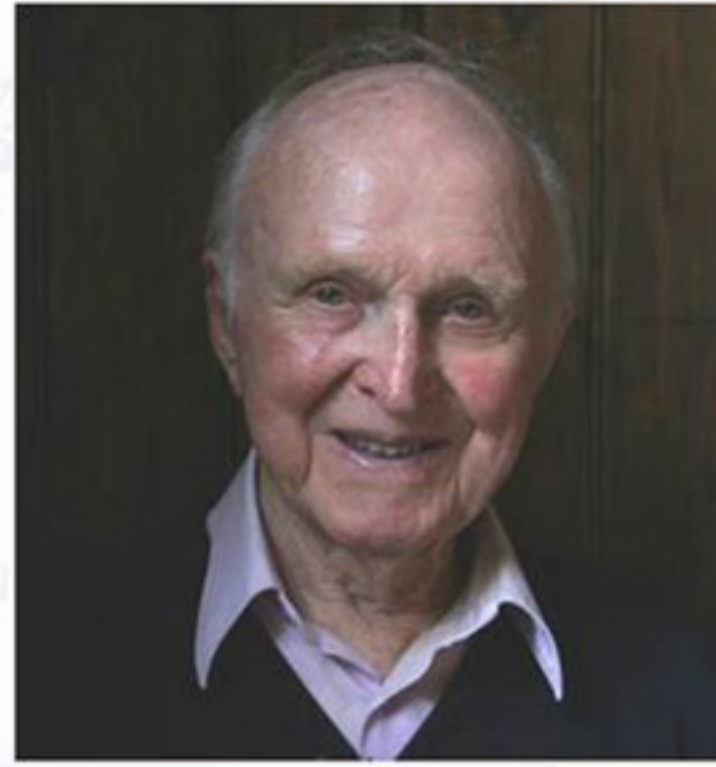
At the age of 102, Colonel Edward Toms has published his authentic and personal insight into a real soldier's experience of war.

One of the last surviving members of the wartime SAS, recruited in Egypt in 1943, his unique story is a stirring mix of experience and honest reflection.

You can follow his journey from the start of the War to being wounded at the battle of Alamein, through Egypt and the Levant to joining Raiding Forces operating on the shores of the north Mediterranean and Adriatic. Returning to his regiment in Northern Europe, he witnessed the end of the War before being sent to join Force 136 in the Far East.

Told with a soldier's humour and the candour of perspective, Colonel Toms never loses humility.
