Seaforth Highlanders WW1 Memorial in Stornoway



This Seaforth Highlanders Plaque in Stornoway was unveiled at The Nicholson Institute on the 14 Sep 1923 located on a clock tower wall. In Aug 2012 a new school was opened on part of the original site incorporating the clock tower, which is a listed building. The Plaque is on the rear of the tower. With the plaque mounted there it is neither visible nor accessible to members of the public. Enquiries are underway to restore and relocate the plaque to a more appropriate setting with support from the Association.
